the first in Bujaru to answer God's call to be trained as local pastors and river missionaries. Benedito is beginning to lead worship and give Bible studies. He has also started a family group in a neighborhood near the church.

House for Bujaru Pastor — We have been asking God for a pastor and Bible teacher to live at the Bujaru church and help open a Bible school to train river pastors. This year God provided funds through your giving to build a house that is currently being used as a dormitory for church camps but will eventually be a home for a senior pastor living on the property in Bujaru. The building was a great help in being able to house some of the 63 young people that came to camp!

Because of your gifts we are able to distribute Bibles to the river people who cannot afford to purchase a Bible of their own. When we make visits to new homes on the

river we first give out used clothes and then Bibles to all who are able to read. For most this is the first Bible that they have ever owned. We share the plan of salvation and invite the family to a church meeting that we will be holding in their area. It is amazing to see how receptive the river people are when they sense that somebody really cares about them. Many invited us to come back and hold a church meeting in their home.

Some of you have asked about little Evelyn... Evelyn is the girl that we wrote about in our updates last October and November. She and her brothers and little sister have been back at her father's house near the Bujaru church for the last 6 months. Because of the help with food baskets that Hope Ministries has been providing, their father Lico has stopped trying to give the children away. However he spends his days at work and the children are alone with no supervision and no one to make sure that they go to school. Please pray for this family and that we would have wisdom to be able to help them in a more permanent way. Our daughter Rachel is continuing with plans to open a home for children at risk in Bujaru.

Visit to orphanage in Southern Brazil - God opened the doors for 6 of our family to make a trip to the Adonai Orphanage in Nepomuceno where 39 years ago, Scott spent 2 years as a counselor to a room of 6 boys. We were able to be there for the 50 year anniversary celebration of the orphanage and hear the testimony of many men, now in their forties and fifties, whose lives were given hope and purpose through the orphanage ministry. It was especially encouraging to see that the boys who Scott cared for those 2-3 years are now walking with the Lord and have stable jobs, beautiful ministries and blessed families.
