Two New Church Plants

The last week of January God blessed with the opening of our 3rd Hope Ministries church in Brazil! The church is located in Acu, a small town of about 1200 people on the Mocajuba River, near the mouth of the Amazon. For now the church is meeting in the home of one of the church members on Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights. Every weekend there is at least one person

Conceição is now our 4th Hope Ministries Church. The first service was held on February 3. Here we are also meeting in the home of one of the church members until we are able to build a church in this community. The living room of the host family measured only 12 ft. by 9 ft. so they opened up the front of their house and added on another 6 feet to make the living room 12 ft. by 15 ft. (new living room pictured below). They could not make the room any bigger without running into the river in front of their home.

The first meeting we had 23 people that came, the second one there were 54. Please pray with us for the families and young people in Conceição. The people are very, very poor and most of them drop out of school at 3rd or 4th grade to work in manioc subsistence farming. The biggest difficulties that these young people face are drug trafficking and again, immorality. Many are abused sexually as small children. This takes away any sense of self worth and destroys all moral standards. They need the healing that only Jesus can bring!

buildings for the congregations meeting in Açu and Conceição. In Açu, one of the church members has already donated a large piece of land for a ministry/training center. We will be building a brick church on this property that will be part of this ministry center. Step one in Açu will be to clear the land and put in the church foundation. (estimated cost - \$3,500.) In Conceição we will be building a wooden church with a dock for medical boat clinics and a well for the community. (Dock - \$2,500, church building materials - \$8,500, labor - \$3,500, well - \$1,000) The living rooms where these church people are meeting are already more than full. Any amount that you give towards helping with these church constructions will be a tremendous blessing and encouragement to these new believers and will open the way to bring many more people to a new life in Jesus.
