



New Moju River Base Established!



New Hope Ministries base at Paritá on the Moju River

God has done a great miracle in taking our family back to the Moju River!

The building above at Paritá was originally built in 2004 by our family and a team from Fields of Harvest Church in Texas for Project Amazon. Three years ago, God confirmed to us that He wanted us to establish a base for Hope Ministries on the Moju River, in the community of Paritá. The area is at a strategic half way point of 8 hours travel from our Bujaru church where our medical boat is docked and the upper Moju River where God is calling us to plant new churches (another 8 hours up river.) After much prayer and sharing our desire with the leaders of Project Amazon, God put it on their hearts to donate this building to Hope Ministries if we could help them relocate their church to the other side of the river. God provided for this and also to purchase another piece of land alongside the building above to give us space for an eventual campgrounds and health center. A team came from Texas to help us clear the land, paint the building and put in 37-foot posts at the river edge for docking our medical boat. We spent one week on the river with the team. Many, many families and young people along the river came to see us and say how happy they were that we are setting up a base for Hope Ministries along the Moju River. They remembered us from the years we had worked there with Project Amazon and were very eager to help us continue to reach into new areas with the gospel.
