### Evelyn's House -Vila Aviva



In order to legalize the safe home the law requires us to change the name of the home from "Evelyn's House" to another name that is not linked to a name of any child we have been caring for. The new name the Lord has given is "VILA AVIVA" which literally means "Coming Alive Home" ("Home That Brings Life").

The nine children that we are working with in the community of Itabira are still living with their mentally deficient aunt. One of the 13 year old girls just had a baby.

#### **Alegre Vamos Church**

This last month we were able to put the roof on our new Alegre Vamos Church! We are praying to be able to complete this building by next spring. It will be used for clinics as well as church services. Pray with us for a worker of God's choosing to send to Alegre Vamos to pastor the people God has given us there.

Each time our medical boat comes to this area we take a day to make visits to the homes along the river in the surrounding communities. Like other areas along the river the immediate need is for helping children at risk. The house right next to the church has 11 children. The 12 year old daughter is expecting a baby next week. God has brought us to this community to help this family as well as for many others where the children and women are being abused. Many younger and older

people here have made a commitment to follow the Lord in the services that we hold. With a church and local pastor established in this community we will have the weekly Bible teaching and discipling necessary to bring about a permanent transformation in their lives and

in their homes.
